**Subject:** Sanction of pending pension cases under Integrated Social Security Scheme(ISSS)

**Government Order No:** 97 - JK(SWD) of 2020  
**Dated:-** 09-04-2020

Sanction is hereby accorded to the sanction of 170000 ( One lakh seventy thousand only) pending pension cases under Integrated Social Security Scheme(ISSS) as per the following breakup:-

The sanction of the pending pension cases is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. Director General, Jammu/Kashmir shall allocate the quota to all the District Social Welfare Officers working under their Administrative control keeping in view the pendency of each district.
2. The cases shall be sanctioned strictly as per the guidelines of the Scheme.
3. Preference shall be given to the pensioners keeping in view their age factor and economic conditions.
4. While sanctioning new cases, the District Social Welfare Officers shall apply due procedures as per the Circular instructions issued by this Department from time to time.
5. District Social Welfare Officers shall sanction these cases w.e.f 01.04.2020 onwards.

**Subject: Measures for financial assistance during the lock down period due to COVID-19.**

**C I R C U L A R**

A 21 day lock down in the entire country has been announced beginning mid night of 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2020. In view of above, following measures shall be taken up immediately:-

**1. Overdraft facility in Jan-Dhan Accounts:**

There are 22.10 lakh Jan Dhan Accounts in UT of J&K, out of which 16.05 lakh accounts are with J&K Bank and rest of 6.05 lakh accounts with other banks. Jan-Dhan Accounts have a built in facility for overdraft which is granted on individual requests. Banks shall be requested to allow this facility to needy persons.

**2. ESIC registered workers:**

There are 2.26 lakh workers registered with ESIC. The Regional Director, ESIC shall be requested to ensure that all ESIC hospitals and employers extend relief/compensation including wages as envisaged in the ESIC scheme promptly to all the insured persons as per directions of Central Government.

**3. J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board:**

 There are a total of 3.50 lakh workers registered with Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board. An assistance of Rs.1000/- per worker costing around Rs.36 crore may be released to registered workers strictly through DBT for purchase of ration.

#### 4. Old Age Pension:

Two installments of pension relating to old age, disability and women in distress may be paid immediately for nearly 7.7 lakh persons including 1.7 lakh pending cases. // ✓.

#### 5. Disaster Management Relief, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction:

Rs.45 crore have been released for the purpose of covering cost of quarantine, cluster containment operation, food, lodging etc. for management of COVID-19 under Disaster Response Fund. It was decided that besides above, free ration to destitutes, daily wage earners under distress, slum dwellers etc. may also be extended under Disaster Response Fund.

#### 6. Entertainment of bills which could not be presented in Treasuries during 2019-20:

There are nearly 6500 DDOs attached with 121 Treasuries. In view of lock down, many bills will not get presented as DDOs may not be able to function fully. Therefore, it was decided that all bills pertaining to authorized works or procurement of goods and services as per rules that could not be presented due to lock down, shall be entertained during 2020-21.


