

Integrated Child Protection Services is a centrally sponsored scheme aimed at building a protective environment for children in difficult circumstances as well as other vulnerable children through Government- Civil Society Partnership. The objective of the ICPS is to bring together multiple existing child protection schemes of the ministry under one comprehensive umbrella and integrates additional interventions for preventing and protecting children from any harm. ICPS deals with the children in conflict with Law and children in need of care and protection. ICPS provides support and rehabilitation services; open shelters for children in need of care in urban and semi-urban areas; family based non-institutional care through Sponsorship, Foster Care, Adoption and After Care. Institutional services – Shelter Homes, Children Homes, Observation Homes, Special Homes, specialized services for children with special needs are also part of child care and protection.

i. Observation Homes

Children in conflict with law who enter the juvenile justice system through the Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs) are in need of adequate residential care and protection during the pendency of any inquiry regarding them under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015 are placed in Observation Homes.

ii. Special Homes

Children in conflict with the law committed by the Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs) for long term rehabilitation and protection are placed in Special Homes.

iii. Shelter Home

Children in need of care and protection who require residential care for a temporary period for one or more reasons are placed in Shelter Homes. These include children without parental care, run away children, migrant children, and child substance abusers etc.

iv. Children Home

Children in need of care and protection who enter the juvenile justice system through the Child Welfare Committees (CWCs) and are in need of residential care and protection during the pendency of any inquiry and subsequently for their long term care, treatment, education, training, development and rehabilitation are placed in Children Home.
